## **Muktinah Trek (4 days)**

Muktinah, at an altitude of 3,710 meters, is one of the major trekking destinations in the Annapurna Region, it lies in the district of Mustang. It is one of the most important destinations for Hindu and Buddhist pilgrimages. The holy shrine at Muktinath is in a grove of trees and includes a Buddhist Gompa and the pagoda style temple of Vishnu Temple, Containing an Image of Vishnu. In addition this trek gives many spectacular views of the two Himalayans Annapurna ranges and Dhaulagiri ranges. The accommodation will be in small lodges on the entire route,

**NOTE**. If you choose this very nice short trekking you should keep in mind that if there will be bad weather in Jomson the flight to go back to Pokara might be delayed.

This means that is highly recommendable to have at least one or two more days before the flight back to your own country.
